Please bring your own practice clothes, shin guards and soccer cleats for practice. Players will be issued new uniforms after these summer practices.

All players must submit a completed *Athletics Participation Permission Form, Athletics Pre-Participation Head-Injury Concussion Form*, and provide all required health information, including a Record of Physical Examination within 13 months prior to the start of the specific athletics season – before you may participate. These forms can be downloaded from the school's website on the *Back to School* page. Please see the 2023 – 2024 Health and Medical Records Requirements letter from our School Nurse.
